Leading sire twice, sire of 24 crops of racing age, 1156 foals, 937 starters, 179 stakes winners, 14 champions, 711 winners of 2267 races and earning \$69,243,155 in N.A., including GULCH (\$3,095,521, Breeders' Cup Sprint [G1], etc.), FORTY NINER (\$2,726,000, Travers S. [G1], etc., set NTR), RHYTHM (\$1,592,532, Breeders' Cup Juvenile [G1], etc.), AFLEET (7 wins, \$995,235, Jerome H. [G1], etc.), Golden Attraction [G1] (\$911,508). Sire of 2000 Kentucky Derby Winner & \$4 million Keeneland Sales yearling FUSAICHI PEGASUS

Mr. Prospector was the highest priced yearling sold at auction in 1971: \$220,000.

Yearling full brother sold for world-record \$625,000 on July 22, 1974, three days

after Mr. Prospector fractured a sesamoid during a workout at Monmouth Park.
Mr. Prospector's retirement was announced on July 26, 1974

1999: died age 29 (complications from colic)

- RAISE A NATIVE: (Major Races Won) = Great American Stakes, Juvenile Stakes (unbeaten during racing career and retired early due to injury)

Set a new track record at Aqueduct, going 5.5 furlongs in 1:02.3; equaled a track record at Aqueduct, going 5 furlongs in 0:57.4

Champion 2-Year Old Colt

1964: retired to stud, went on to become leading sire, stood at Spendthrift Farm, sire of 24 crops of racing age, 863 foals, 584 starters, 77 stakes winners, 2 champions, 434 winners of 1445 races and earning \$17,827,990 in North America, among the leading broodmare sires, sire of dams of 158 stakes winners, including Champions KISS A NATIVE, BLUE FINN, AJDAL, MANCHEGO, PI PHI PRINCE, CANANGO, LEGARTO, BANDEIRA NATIVA, DANZATORE, DOUBLE HELIX, TEMPERENCE OAKS, IRISH SHOAL, and ELMHURST

Dam of 12 foals, 6 runners, 6 winners, 4 stakes winners (Quarter Horse Simply Royal, SI-101, and Thoroughbreds Something Lovely, SomethingToCatch and Simply Catchy; the latter 2 are sprinters – other winners are an allowance-winning Appaloosa and winning Thoroughbred on stock tracks Something Catchy), 1 Champion (Champion 3-Year-Old Filly Simply Catchy)

2nd dam of winners Hammer Down, South Carolina Bay, Simple Betty, Simply Quick, Reve du Soliel, Easily Fast, and stakes winners Simple Hammer, Sea Secret, We Be Jammin', and Astro Centaurus

¾-sister to A. P. INDY, ½-sister to 2 Grade I multiple stakes winners, and ½-sister to producer Someday (unraced dam of 4 runners, 4 winners, 3 stakes winners [Eagle Point, High Seas, and Bristol Bay Trader])
